Position Title: Worship/Music Minister (Part Time Position, 12.5 hours/week)
Supervisor: Campus Pastor
Purpose: To organize, administer and oversee all elements of worship

PRIMARY DUTIES:

1. Be responsible for worship bands, rehearsals and leading worship for all worship services.
2. Keep up with Planning Center details each week.
3. Prepare worship set each week designated by the Central Creative Team.
4. Serve as the supervisor for all musicians.
5. Constantly recruit and train new musicians and vocalists.
6. Oversee the Director of Audio Visual Ministries to insure proper audio, multimedia video and lighting on a weekly basis.
7. Assist to develop youth age bands to be used both in youth worship and at times in the children's and adults' worship services.
8. Provide private musical instruction for worship team members where necessary.
9. Arrange custom music for voices and instruments.
10. Be responsible for any other musical elements for programs within the church.
11. Uphold the Staff Covenant.
