

DAY 7: KINGDOM BUILDER

Crosspoint has defined the fourth role of a Disciple as a “kingdom builder”. So, all together, a disciple of Jesus is a faithful follower, helpful neighbor, deployed disciple, and then a kingdom builder. As kingdom builders, we take in the 30,000 foot view of the world, where we recognize that it’s not just about us, it’s not just about Crosspoint, but we are on mission expanding the Kingdom of God as a whole. There’s a movement from our individual relationship with God to the larger Kingdom of God that should naturally happen in a disciple. God calls us to be global Christians.

It’s daunting to pray for the world! But at Crosspoint, we can do that by praying for the 60+ missionaries and the many partner organizations we support locally and around the world. For this reason, every Sunday we highlight a mission or missionary of the week. We pray! And fasting super-powers our prayer!

In Matthew 17:16-21, the disciples come to Jesus unable to handle a demonized man. Jesus responds: “This kind comes out only by prayer and fasting.” There are things accomplished in God’s world by serious prayer only, by fasting prayer. As we think about praying within our kingdom building roles, what are the first three global connections you know about?

Pray now for those ministries, persons, missionaries or nations. We’re all connected to different places and different people. It’s not overwhelming if we just pray for whoever God lays upon our hearts at a time. As we get into our prayer zones, we should ask the Holy Spirit to inspire us as to who to pray for each day. If someone comes to mind, pray!

P.R.A.Y.

Pause: Try this breath prayer: Jesus, you love the world. I love your world, too.

Rejoice: What people, ministries, pastors, missionaries have impacted your life? Make a list and then praise God for these.

Ask: List 10 countries. Pray for spiritual leadership in those nations. Pray for the lost and dying.

Make a list of 10 Christian workers you know or have heard of then pray for them (effectiveness, health, safety, divine favor).

Jesus taught his disciples to pray for God’s provision as they cast out a demon. What provisions does Crosspoint need to be a Kingdom-minded church?

Pray for that:
