Purpose:	To oversee, lead, and facilitate the recreation programs of Crosspoint for community engagement and outreach.

- 7. Plan, submit and oversee the budget of the Recreation Ministry as well as all other financial aspects of the ministry to ensure that everything is done in accordance with Crosspoint guidelines.

- 9. Work with the facility team to ensure proper set-up of events in CLC.
- 10. Strategize ways to engage with the Niceville community to reach more people in our community.
- 11. Build relationships with other Crosspoint ministry areas to foster a healthy engagement between Recreation and other ministries (i.e. Kids, Academies, Students, etc.)
- 12. Any additional duties as assigned by supervisor.
