

### **PASTORAL LETTER**

Dear Crosspoint Church Family,

I love this church! I love the people of this church. I love the mission of this church. I love the heart of this church for those who don't know Jesus yet. I love the generosity of this church. I love the ministries of this church, and I love where God is leading us!

Where God is leading us is toward Awakening. Our country and culture need nothing less than another great spiritual Awakening like we've seen in the past. The Awaken Campaign is another step in doing our part to bring that kind of spiritual revival to life in Northwest Florida and beyond. Our belief is clear - Awaken the Church; Awaken the World.

If the Church will wake up to our main mission of making disciples who make disciples, then people in our world will come awake to faith in Jesus! It's like Paul said in Ephesians 5:14 (NIV) "Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

When Christ shines His light on us as we awaken to His will and ways, we become a light to the world around us. So let's WAKE UP!

To further our mission to make disciples who make disciples, we're taking a bold step in the fastest-growing city in Florida. Many of you know that from 2012 to 2022, the city of Freeport grew by an incredible 256%, and as it continues to grow, so does our Freeport Campus! This gives us a unique chance to build something with explosive Kingdom potential as we seek to build a new campus building in Freeport to keep up with what God is already doing.

Our dream for the Freeport Campus isn't just about bricks and mortar; it's about community impact, life change, and fostering a disciple-making movement.

The new building we're planning is not just for us; it's a gift to the community meant to bless, engage, and draw in people. This meets a huge community need as the only indoor space in Freeport where young and old can come for sports like basketball, soccer, and indoor pickleball. How amazing will it be to have a hub for recreation and connection that brings the community together?

Additionally, this new facility will house our Crosspoint Academy preschool, meeting a desperate need in this fast-growing community. It's a chance to nurture and support the youngest among us, laying a strong foundation of faith. Christian morals, and excellent learning.

This new building will combine some of the best elements of Crosspoint: engaging contemporary worship services, amazing Kids ministry, excellent Christ-centered early childhood education and care, Christ-focused recreation, and community impact. In some ways it seems like a no-brainer already, but there's more.

All of this ultimately furthers our new mission and The 2035 Dream you will read more about in this book. So far, a year and a half after rolling out our goals of seeing 2,000 unique roles named and lived out, 3,000 first-time conversions to Christ, and 500 communities of faith equipped to start their disciple-making by the year 2035; we've seen the following results:

- 303 people named their unique role through DiscipleStory
- Over 400 people gave their life to Jesus for the first time
- And around 20 churches began the process of starting their unique disciple-making movement

God is on the move! None of these goals are about growing a bigger attendance; they are all about equipping you to connect others and equipping other churches.

And we believe that impact will be furthered greatly as we expand in Freeport! As we consider an expanding attendance in Freeport, the fastest-growing city, and all the combined elements God is bringing together, building this new facility becomes essential.

The question we all need to ask is how does God want us to join in this effort. As you read and work through this book through our 5-week Awaken series, pray that God will Awaken the Church to Awaken the World. Pray for how He wants you to be involved with your time, and with the finances He's given you. Everyone will have to contribute both prayer and finances to see this happen. Use this book in your own personal time with God, as you listen to sermons, and share in Christian community, and reflect on what this new building means for our community and how you can be a vital part of it.

Thank you for your constant prayers, your generosity, and for being the amazing church family you are. I love this church!

# WISION

Imagine a church where every member knows what it means to be a disciple and knows their unique role in God's mission of making disciples. Imagine a church where students are launched into the world as uniquely deployed disciple-makers with an understanding of their personal calling in the mission of God.

### What if Crosspoint could become that kind of church?

The Awaken Campaign isn't about a building or a program. It's about us "waking from our spiritual slumber" to partner with God in becoming the church He's called us to be. It's about helping people in our own circle of influence wake up to faith in Jesus and become the unique disciple-maker they've been created to be. Crosspoint is a sleeping giant in many ways, that if awakened could play a major role in God's plan to awaken the people of Northwest Florida and beyond.



# **AWAKEN THE CHURCH**

The first step in an Awakening is to awaken the church. The difference between a powerful revival and a true Great Awakening, which our country has seen twice before and is currently in desperate need of, is disciples who live out our mission to make other disciples. The Awaken Campaign is primarily about Crosspoint becoming that kind of church.

Once awakened to our mission as a uniquely-deployed disciple, we in turn awaken others in our circles of influence to faith in Jesus. Until that happens, we will never see the kind of Awakening our world desperately needs.

# GOALS

### AWAKEN CAMPAIGN PURPOSE

Build a new community-oriented building for the Freeport Campus to further disciple-making and community impact




The Freeport Campus was launched in January 2020, seven weeks before we shut down due to the pandemic. Remarkably, by the power of God's Spirit and the people of Crosspoint, the campus was not only able to survive being closed for twice as long as it was open, but is now thriving and growing at a rate that the current building won't be able to sustain much longer.



Currently, the Freeport Campus averages 262 people in worship attendance, which is larger than its attendance pre-pandemic (179). This growth, combined with being located in the fastest-growing city percentage-wise in Florida from 2012-2022 (256%), indicates that Kingdom growth is just beginning at this campus. AWAKENING IS HAPPENING!



God obviously wants Crosspoint in the fastest-growing city in Florida for a reason: to advance His disciple-making mission in the way He's uniquely designed us. Our vision is to make disciples and impact this growing community through worship services, groups, missions, a Crosspoint Academy providing a much-needed Christ-centered preschool, and a gym to provide indoor recreation opportunities for all ages. Our call is to continue partnering with God to connect even more people to Christ throughout Walton County through this campus.

Though Crosspoint hadn't yet coined the term "unique roles in God's mission," we felt a dream brewing in our hearts: to introduce Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu to the city of Freeport. One day, brimming with excitement, we approached Sam, the Freeport Campus Pastor, with our idea. This wasn't just a business venture for us; it was a heartfelt calling to enrich the community through discipline, camaraderie, and personal growth.

In a bold move, we proposed partnering with Crosspoint to establish our Jiu-Jitsu classes on the campus. Enthusiastic about the potential impact and after much prayer, we embraced this unconventional idea, feeling that God was opening a door for us. For two years, we set up and tore down our Academy in the children's space, transforming it into a lively center. We welcomed around 90 participants of all ages, five to six days a week.

The ripple effect was extraordinary. Our classes didn't just attract students to do Jiu-Jitsu; it also brought their families to our Freeport Campus, filling the space with life and energy.

Driving by in the evenings, seeing the campus bustling with cars and activity, was a testament to the impact of opening our doors to the community and providing a recreational space at the Freeport Campus. This experience reinforced our belief in the power of discovering our unique roles in God's mission and the importance of community engagement.

We've seen multiple families from Jiu-Jitsu become involved in the life of the church. And we've had families be introduced to the Jiu-Jitsu art through our church. A real community relationship with the local Church!

# THE BAILEY FAMILY

Maddie Bailey, a ten-year-old girl, visited our Freeport Campus with her family one Sunday. After attending a service, Maddie expressed a deep desire to know Jesus. In a powerful moment, right there in the lobby, she made a decision and prayed to receive Christ. Her decision to follow Christ, followed by her baptism, catalyzed a chain of four spontaneous baptisms the following Sunday, marking a profound impact on her family and others in our congregation.

When Jessica, Maddie's mom, was asked why they chose Crosspoint for their church that Sunday, her response was both touching and insightful. She said, "When Maddie woke up that morning and said she wanted to go to church, I knew it was time to take action. We chose Crosspoint because it felt familiar," she explained. Her husband David, was curious, "Why does it feel familiar?" She reminded him, "Don't you remember? Our son used to do Jiu-Jitsu in the kids' building there! It felt like a safe and welcoming place, and we've heard great things about the community and the Pastor."



These stories, like many others, began with Crosspoint's commitment to being open-handed with our facilities. By welcoming various community activities—whether it's Jiu-Jitsu, music lessons, or other programs—We create spaces where people feel comfortable, loved, and can come as they are. This approach not only meets practical needs but also opens doors for spiritual encounters that lead to disciples being made.

# GIVING JOURNEY

This tool is designed to help you change money from being an idol to money being used as a tool for God's Kingdom. The journey focuses on the condition of our hearts, transforming us into the likeness of Christ. Each step of the giving journey represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice.

### INITIAL GIVER

Partnership in the gospel | Philippians 1:5-6

An **INITIAL GIVER** is someone who decides to give for the first time, out of response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the church with this gift.

**QUESTION TO ASK**: God, do I trust You as my Provider? Show me how to demonstrate to You my trust in You by starting somewhere and beginning to give.

### **CONSISTENT GIVER**

Since you have excelled, excel here too | 2 Corinthians 8:7

A **CONSISTENT GIVER** is someone who decides to give something and to give it on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online recurring gift will be someone who is learning the behavior of consistency. Non-online givers can be consistent givers as well, of course; it just requires more discipline.

**QUESTION TO ASK**: The apostle Paul says we should excel in the grace of giving. God, am I giving on a consistent basis that shows my desire to excel in this area of discipleship? Show me how to become more consistent and disciplined in my giving.

### **INTENTIONAL GIVER**

Making your giving purposeful | Luke 14:28-30

An **INTENTIONAL GIVER** is someone who thinks about their giving in relation to their other financial priorities. This giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they prioritize it in relation to other things on which they spend their money.

**QUESTION TO ASK**: Does my giving accurately reflect how I feel about God? Or do some changes need to be made? God, show me what it looks like to truly recognize You are my priority and that I should give in such a way that puts You first.

### **SURRENDERED GIVER**

Jesus went first and gave it all, so we surrender our lives to Him | Colossians 1:15-20

A **SURRENDERED GIVER** is someone who recognizes the power of the gospel and is surrendered to honoring God with 100% of their resources. This giver isn't just concerned with what they ARE giving, but is more concerned with what they're NOT giving and why.

**QUESTION TO ASK**: God, what am I NOT giving and why? Am I truly honoring You with 100% of what You have given me, not just a portion? God show me what it looks like to honor You with all my heart, soul, and mind.


### **ETERNAL GIVER**

Our hope is not in earthly things, but eternal things | 1 Timothy 6:6-19

An **ETERNAL GIVER** is someone who thinks about the long-term impacts of generosity rather than just the short term. They make decisions in the short term that have long-term effects. This giver is driven by the things of eternity, putting their hope in God and not in the things of this earth.

**QUESTION TO ASK**: God, do I make large resource decisions in light of eternity or in light of my time here on earth? God, show me how to better recognize that all things are submissive to You and driven by my love and devotion for You – not for the purpose of merely this moment, but for the purpose of eternity.

## **HOW TO MAKE A COMMITMENT**





### QUESTIONS TO PRAYERFULLY CONSIDER BEFORE GIVING

One of the questions that first comes to our mind when considering how much to give is: how much can I/we afford to give? That is a valid question, but as you get alone with God to listen in faith, we ask you to consider the following questions as well:

- God, is this something you want me/us to sacrificially give toward?
   And if so, God, what do you want me/us to give? I/We want my/our gift to be pleasing to you.
- In considering this gift, think sacrificially. This gift will be above and beyond my/our regular giving. I/we give as an act of worship because God has first self-sacrificially given to me/us. Our response reflects who He is in our lives. Another question might be: Are there any ways I/we can sacrifice something I/we am/are currently spending on to give to God's mission because God has given to me/us so generously?
- Think creatively about a comprehensive giving plan. This commitment is for 3 years, so it doesn't all have to be upfront. Consider: Are there any resources or assets I/we could use as a gift beyond my income?
- As you prayerfully consider your commitment, ask yourself: How is it demonstrating an expression of faith? Does my/our gift honor God? Is it a gift that would be pleasing to Him, not just pleasing to me/us.

# AWAKEN FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What exactly are you asking me to do?

First and foremost, we are asking you to pray and seek God's direction. We ask you to prioritize Sunday worship services and prepare your heart to listen to God's Word. Additionally, take time to reflect on the messages each week and talk with your family and friends about what the Lord is revealing to you. We trust that the Lord will direct you as you pray about what commitment you should make.

Mark your calendar for Commitment Sunday on October 20, and make plans to be part of this special worship service as we celebrate how the Lord is working in and through us. We trust that the Lord is working in your life, in our church, and in our community, and we look forward in faith to the tremendous impact that He will make through our commitment.

### What is the "right amount" for me, or for us as a family, to give?

The "right amount" is the amount that God places on your heart to give sacrificially. Your commitment is an act of worship. The apostle Paul says in 2 Corinthians 9:6-7 that "Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

### What if I can't afford to give right now?

We believe that the Awaken Campaign will be a time where God asks our members to give generously. For some, this may mean giving sacrificially. Perhaps the Lord is asking you to sell something, cut back in certain areas, or even trust God in faith by making a commitment that you believe God will provide for as you seek Him. We are asking everyone to be part of the Awaken Campaign so we can all support, love, encourage, and pray for one another.

# What if I'm moving within the next three years, or if I'm uncertain about how long I'll be a part of Crosspoint?

The truth is that none of us know exactly what our future holds. That's the beauty and challenge of taking steps of faith! We want to encourage you even if you're not sure if you will be part of Crosspoint for the next three years; we invite you to still commit generously and be part of this life-changing endeavor God has for our church. If needed, you may modify your commitment at any time. But often, people continue to support Crosspoint as a ministry because they want to be part of the future. If you happen to move out of the area, we would love for that to be part of your story!

### What if I am new to Crosspoint?

If you are new to our church – WELCOME! We would love to connect with you at Connection Point outside your worship venue. At this time, we're not asking you to make a financial commitment to our Awaken Campaign. However, if you have questions about Awaken and would like to discuss it further, please let us know! We'd be happy to share our vision with you and answer any questions you have. Attend Discover Crosspoint to learn more about who we are, what we do, how to connect, and how to get better connected.

### Can I change my commitment?

Of course! Unforeseen circumstances may cause you to want to increase or decrease your giving commitment in the future. At any time during the next three years, you may review or change your commitment.

### Can we raise this much money above our annual budget needs?

Most churches typically raise about two to three times their annual giving in a capital campaign. After reviewing our financial picture, the proposed building design, and projected construction and long-term costs, our administrative board prayerfully considered and approved the goal of \$15.5 million. We believe that through the faith and generosity of God's people, this goal is possible.

# Will the Awaken Campaign have a negative effect on funding for any current ministry areas?

We do not expect the Awaken Campaign to have an adverse effect on our normal operating or missions outreach budgets, as all commitments toward the Awaken Campaign are made over and above regular giving. Historically, churches do not experience decreases in regular giving during a capital campaign. Instead, the overall focus on stewardship and generosity stirs individuals and families to be more intentional in both their regular tithes and campaign commitments.

# How does the Awaken Campaign fit into Crosspoint's vision and the 2035 Dream?

The Awaken Campaign is one of the leading tools that will enable us to accomplish Crosspoint's vision and the 2035 Dream. We anticipate increased community outreach through this new campus location with a Community Life Center and a preschool (Crosspoint Academy). We expect to see more people connecting people to Christ and their unique role in God's mission, more disciple-makers who have found and are living out their unique role in God's mission, and more first time conversions to Christ. This campus will also enlarge our network of faith communities that are becoming disciple-makers as we expand our reach eastward across Northwest Florida and beyond.

### What is the schedule for the capital campaign and building?

We plan to move into the building and begin using the Community Life Center and open Crosspoint Academy by late 2026.



# WE DESIRE TO SEE A CULTURE OF DISCIPLES MAKING DISCIPLES

The goal of this section is to help you develop in the spiritual disciplines of Bible reading and journaling. Like everything else in our spiritual life, what we learn is meant to be shared with others. As you develop in these disciplines, think about how you might help others learn and grow in theirs as well. Disciples are always meant to make other disciples.

We pray that this tool will help you grow in your faith and go make disciples of Jesus where you live, work, and play.

**H.E.A.R.** stands for **Highlight**, **Explain**, **Apply**, and **Respond** which is a method developed by Robby Gallaty and Replicate Ministries. Each of these four action steps help create an environment for us to hear God speak into our life.

Before reading a passage each day, pause to sincerely ask God to speak to you. It may not seem like a big deal, but it is extremely important to seek the Holy Spirit's guidance in order to understand God's Word.

On the next page, you will find an outline of the H.E.A.R. method that will help you on your journey through God's Word!

This reading plan provides a focused study on each church mentioned in Revelation 2-3, supplemented with relevant passages to widen understanding. Each week targets a different church, providing both context and practical applications of their teachings and encouragements.

### HIGHLIGHT

After reading the passage of Scripture, highlight the verses that speak to you by copying them into your journal. Then circle, highlight, or underline keywords or concepts in those verses.

### **EXPLAIN**

At this stage, you will engage the text and wrestle with its meaning. By asking some simple questions, and prayerfully leaning on the help of the Holy Spirit, you can better understand the meaning of a passage or verse. Here are a few questions to get you started:

- To whom was it originally written?
- Why was it written?
- How does it fit with the verses before and after it?
- What is God intending to communicate within this text?
- What does this passage say about who God is, or humanity?

### **APPLY**

Application is a key step of the process. Everything culminates under this heading. As you have done before, ask a series of questions to uncover the significance of these verses to you personally. Questions like:

- What does this mean today?
- What is God saying to me personally?
- How can I apply this message to my life?

### **RESPOND**

Your response to the passage may take on many forms. You may write a call to action. You may describe how you will be different because of what God has said. You may indicate what you are going to do because of what you have learned. You may respond by writing out a prayer. For example, you may ask God to help you to be more loving, or to give you a desire to be more generous in your giving. Keep in mind that this is your response to what you have read and heard from God.
