•• He Question: What kind of kid was Jesus?

Brite Idea: Jesus never sinned, but He understands our temptation.	We Question: How can Jesus help us when we are tempted to sin?		
He Question: Did Jesus ever sin?	Because Jesus was fully human, He understands our temptatio

Nicodemus (John 3:1-21)	Week 3		

Brite Idea: Jesus gives eternal life.

- He Question: How is Jesus able to give us eternal life?
- Because He was fully man, Jesus could take the punishment for our sin by dying on the cross. Because He was fully God, Jesus was the perfect sacrifice and defeated death by rising from the dead.

Friends Bring a Man to Jesus (Mark 2:1-12)

Brite Idea: Jesus forgives and heals.

- **He Question:** How did Jesus show He was God?
- While on Earth, Jesus performed many amazing miracles and forgave people of their sins. Because Jesus is the Son of God, He has the power to forgive sins and to heal.

We Question: How can we have eternal life?

God offers His salvation as a free gift from His grace. If we believe in Jesus and trust Him alone for forgiveness of our sins, we can have eternal life.



We Question: Why should we help our friends know about lesus?

Jesus is the only way for us to be forgiven and made right with God. Living God's way is the best way, so the most loving thing we can do for our friends is help them know Jesus.

Discuss how Satan tempted Jesus with food and discuss how He responded.	JOHN 1:14 How did Jesus dwell among people?	Play a board game together. Discuss the temptation to cheat to win and talk about Jesus' sinless life in spite of many temptations.	Tell your kid(s) the story of the day they were born. READ TOGETHER: John 3:3-4 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 Jesus gives eternal life. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: John 1:9-10 Why did the world not know Him?	Look together at the clouds and see if you can spot any animal outlines. Discuss heaven and eternal life.	JOHN 1:14 Who is the "we" John is talking about?	Give kid(s) a short chore list and compensate them when finished. Discuss the free gift of eternal life.	Build a fort but leave an opening in the roof. Lower items into the fort. READ TOGETHER: Isaiah 43:25 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 4 Jesus forgives and heals. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: John 1:11-12 What happens to those who receive Him and believe in His name?	Create some barriers in a room. Carry your kid through the room as you push through the barriers.	JOHN 1:14 Had God's glory been seen before Jesus came to Earth?	Draw an outline of a person. Grab some bandages and put them on the outline. Discuss how Jesus heals.	Go on a walk through your neighbor- hood. Pray for everyone to know the love of Christ. READ TOGETHER: 1 John 1:9 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
