Monthly Memory Verse

For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.
(Proverbs 2:6)

GOD'S WISDOM (Proverbs 2-3)

Week 1

Brite Idea: God is the source of all wisdom.

He Question: Where does wisdom come from?

God is the true source of all wisdom. Since He is omniscient, He always knows what is best and right.

We Question: Why is it important for us to seek God's wisdom?

Our knowledge and understanding are limited. God's is not. His way is always the right way, and He wants to give us His wisdom.

WISDOM WITH FRIENDS (Proverbs 13:20, 17:17, 27:17)

Week 2

Brite Idea: God gives us wisdom for friendships.

He Question: What kind of friend is Jesus?

Jesus is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. He loves at all times. He is the perfect friend and is an example to us of how to be a friend.

We Question: What kind of friend does God want us to be?

We must be wise in choosing our friendships. God wants us to help our friends be more like Him by choosing kindness, loyalty and honesty.

WISDOM WITH WORDS (Proverbs 18:21, 10:19, 15:1, 12:18)

Week 3

Brite Idea: God gives us wisdom in how we speak.

He Question: Does God care how I speak to others?

God wants me to honor Him and others with my words. Our words can be used to bring Him glory rather than hurt others.

We Question: Why do our words matter?

Our words are powerful. Our words can hurt others and ruin our own lives. God calls us to be wise in how we speak.

WISDOM IN HOW WE USE MONEY (Proverbs 3:9-10, 30:7-9)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God gives us wisdom in how we use money.

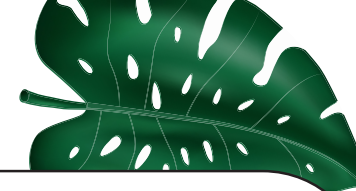
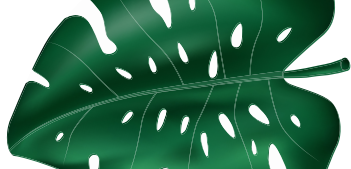
He Question: Does God care about money?

WEEK 2 ----- God gives us wisdom for friendships. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 13:20 Why do we need to be careful who we spend our time with?	Play "Guess the Friend." Each family member will share a fact about a friend. Other family members guess whom they are describing.	PROVERBS 2:6 Who gives us wisdom?	Invite family friends over for a game night, snacks, or crafting!	Allow kids to interview the grown-ups about their childhood friendships. READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 18:21, 10:19, 15:1, 12:18 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 ----- God gives us wisdom in how we speak. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 10:19 Is it easy for you to "restrain your lips"? Why or why not?	Create speech bubbles to leave encouraging messages around the home. Use sticky notes or draw on mirrors with dry-erase markers.	PROVERBS 2:6 How can we learn about God's knowledge and understanding?	Challenge each other to be encouragers at school and work. Share about what you said to encourage someone and how they reacted.	Play Catchphrase or Taboo. Talk about the importance of thinking before you speak. READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 3:9-10, 30:7-9 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 4 ----- God gives us wisdom in how we use money. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 3:9-10 What are firstfruits? What is an example of your firstfruits?	Make a family "Save, Spend, Give" set of jars and discuss how God wants us to use our money.	PROVERBS 2:6 Why do you think God chooses to give us His wisdom?	Choose a mission or service project to give to as a family.	Hold a garage sale and give your profits to a favorite charity. READ TOGETHER: Genesis 1 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
