

**STUDENT MINISTRY SUMMER INTERN**

- Position Title:** Student Ministry Summer Intern (Part-Time; Ministerial Exempt Position)
- Supervisor:** Associate Student Minister, Niceville Campus
- Purpose:** To gain hands-on ministry experience by assisting the Niceville Campus Student Ministry with planning, coordinating and executing student ministry at the Niceville Campus. To serve alongside regular staff, learn the operations of the church and grow in leadership, character and personal walk with Christ.

**PRIMARY DUTIES:**

1. Work with Associate Student Minister to promote student ministry programming. Meet with Associate Student Minister once weekly during internship for planning and implementation of ministry needs.
2. Lead a Student Multiply Group once a week.
3. Promote, attend and model hospitality during the 9:30 am middle school service. Engage students in worship and relationship pre and post service and speak at service on occasion.
4. Attend Crosspoint Students summer activities and events and engage students in Biblical discussion, connection and fellowship among peers.
5. Work with Associate Student Minister to develop and implement a plan to follow up on new students and contact inactive students. Contact and connect with students via social media (Facebook) as well as through personal contact (phone calls, texts, postcards, face-to-face contact).
6. Work with Student Minister to develop and implement a specific plan for promoting outreach and hospitality among students. Model, train and lead students in hospitality. Involve students in reaching new visitors and getting them connected into the student ministry program.
7. Work with student ministry to plan, organize, coordinate and participate in special events, including the spiritual components and directions of the events. Participation in Vacation Bible School and Mission Northwest is extremely vital to help further the connection between students and the church/ministry.
8. Uphold and adhere to the Staff Covenant.

**SKILLS DESIRED:**

1. Be a dedicated Christian growing in a deepening personal relationship with Jesus Christ, and modeling this to others. This includes a commitment to Bible reading, prayer, and sanctification as a Christian in all areas of life.
2. Strong leadership, communication, organizational, team building, and relational skills.
3. Ability to recruit, train and empower students in engaging their peers.
4. Warm, friendly and engaging personality.

**PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:**
