KIDS MINISTER, FREEPORT CAMPUS

Position Title:	Kids Minister Part-Time, Ministerial Exempt
Supervisor:	Campus Pastor
Purpose:	To champion the vision of People Connecting People to Christ & Their Unique Role In God's Mission through Kids Ministry. This is primarily carried out by creating an environment where kids birth through fifth grade are known, loved and disciplined to follow Jesus. This role is responsible for building relational ministry environments, developing and discipling teams, partnering with parents, and creating a culture where every child has the opportunity to grow in his or her faith.

PRIMARY DUTIES:

1. Lead the Crosspoint Kids teams (including Elementary, Preschool, Nursery and Guest Services) in carrying out and implementing the overall Crosspoint Kids Ministry strategy and disciple-making pathway.
2. Champion a ministry culture focused on transformation, relationships and spiritual growth.
3. Equip families with tools and resources to disciple kids at home.
4. Build, encourage and train a strong team of volunteers who are passionate about discipling kids.
5. Invest in relationships with volunteer teams through regular connection, prayer, encouragement, and personal development.
6. Regularly evaluate the effectiveness of kids ministry practices and procedures at the Freeport Campus through the lens of life change and connection.
7. Ensure strict adherence to Crosspoint's Safe Environment Policy.
8. Manage ministry resources and budget responsibly and effectively.
9. Build trust with families through clear and consistent communication via Kids Ministry webpage, eLetter, special events, and serving opportunities
10. Schedule childcare periodically for Life Groups and/or events
11. Uphold the Staff Covenant

PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

8. Occasionally lifts, transports and/or pushes moderate weight items up 30 pounds.
9. Works primarily in an indoor environment.
10. Work environment noise level is frequently low to moderate, but may occasionally be high.

KEY PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENTS:

1. Develop a growing team of spiritually healthy, equipped, and engaged volunteers.
2. Build strong relationships with families and parents.
3. Demonstrate evidence of kids growing in faith and participation.
4. Kid's environments are well-kept and updated to keep kids engaged.
5. Strengthen alignment between kids ministry and Crosspoint's overall disciple making vision.
